This will be a Celebration of the Fine Arts at St. Pete Christian. It will be a combined effort of the K4-4 students and our Upper Division Band.

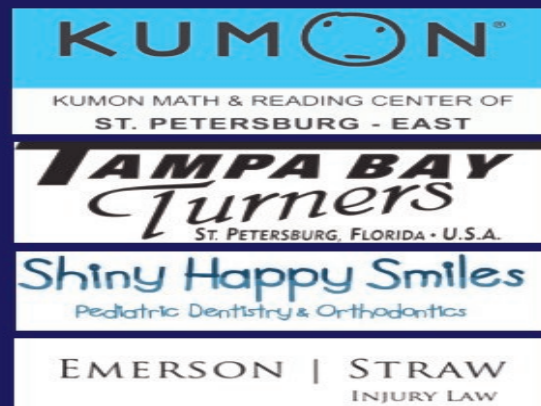

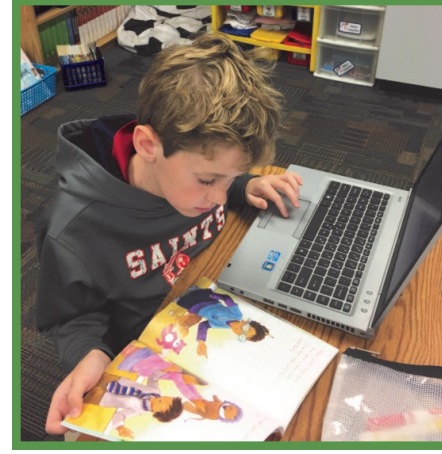
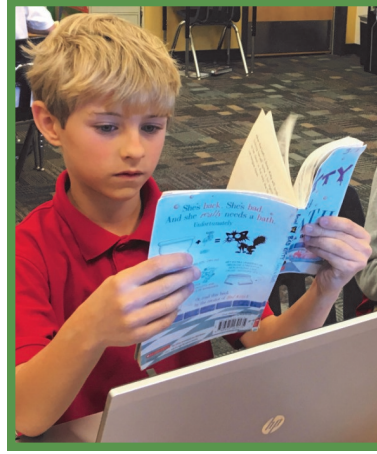
SPCS Students Share Talents
