"Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights" (James 1:17).




Congratulations to the members of the 2020 SPCS Bowling Team. They compete at Sunrise Lanes and invite everyone to come watch them in action!


6th Grade English Update


TIMOTHY AWARD RECIPIENTS
